Set up details:

- Set up time is from 7:00 – 8:30 am
- **FREE** parking is available behind the Municipal Center after set up.
- **NO** vehicles are allowed on the church grounds after set up. All remaining vehicles will be towed at the owner's expense. Your space must be set up by 8:30 am on the morning of Old Home Day.
- Plan to leave your space set up until 5:00 pm.

Fees and Space details:

- **\$50 (non-refundable)**
- **Free for non-profit organizations** (non-profit space is limited and available based on sponsor discretion). Non-profit spaces will be assigned based on availability in crafter area and/or other event spaces.
- In addition to fee, we request that each vendor/crafter donate a craft or appropriate item for our Penny Sale. You can drop the item off with one of your business cards when you register on the morning of September 17th.
- All spaces are 10' x 10'.
- All canopies, tables and chairs are the responsibility of the vendor/crafter
- Canopies must be no larger than 10' x 10' and cannot overlap into designated walkways, if canopy is larger than 10' x 10' then additional space must be reserved.
- **Deadline for securing space is Tuesday, August 30, 2011**

Restrictions: Non-compliance with these restrictions will result in us closing your space.

- We **DO NOT** allow spaces for political candidates or controversial subject matter.
- **RAFFLES ARE NOT ALLOWED. The only raffle permitted is run by the OHD committee.** You can hold drawings for goods or services, as long as there is NO CHARGE to participate.
- **Pelham UCC restricts the sale/use of weapon type toys.** PLEASE DO NOT SELL GUNS, SWORDS, KNIVES OR WEAPONS OF ANY SORT. This includes bang caps and accessories.
- **Pelham UCC restricts the sale of nuisance items** such as "Silly String" and "Disappearing Ink".
